5.0 ANNUAL PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2013-2014

Since the last AGM of October 2014 the Board of Management has met on the second Tuesday of each month. The exception has been the month of January, where there was no meeting during the festive holidays.

ACSE and IStructE

The ACSE and IStructE continued to work together during 2013-2014. Our reciprocal agreement means that all ACSE members are invited to attend all IStructE seminars. The NSW President of IStructE is also invited to be a member of the judging panel for the ACSE Structural engineering excellence awards.

Breakfast CPD Seminars

Safety in Design Talk & Breakfast - 8th April 2014

This event provided attendees with an understanding of the background and legislative requirements surrounding safety in design; providing a simplified approach to preparing a SID project report and providing practising engineers with an opportunity to discuss an important current issue and hear from a structural engineer's first-hand experience. This successful event attracted 70 engineers. The event was sponsored by TTW who provided the venue and Constructive Recruitment who provided breakfast for everyone.

Succession Planning Seminar – 29th July 2014

Presented by Keith Drewery of KPMG who is experienced in identifying practical solutions specialising in inter-generational wealth management and succession planning. Keith reviewed various models of succession planning for consulting engineering practices. This event was the first business focussed event for members and was well received by 20 attendees.

Annual Seminar 2014

Advances in Structural Materials - Designing Beyond the Codes The 2014 Annual Seminar was held on 4th September 2014.

Talks included: *The Latest in Structural Design of Tensile Membrane Structures*. Presented by Mike Lester, Managing Director of Mak Max. Scheme design techniques. What can be done and what to look for. Case Study – 2014 World Cup Stadium. *Advances in Steel Fibre Reinforced Concrete*. Presented by Ian Ross, Engineering Manager and CEO, BOSFA. Ultimate design using fibres. Design for a combination of fibres and steel. *Simplified Design Method for Seismic Retrofitting of Buildings*. Presented by Dr Ali Habibi, The University of Queensland. Designing for retrofitting of existing buildings with sacrificial energy dissipation devices; and *Designing in Structural Glass*. Presented by Peter Hartigan and Jie Wen, Façade Engineers, ARUP, for 8 Chifley Square.

Approximately 40 people attended the seminar and the dinner afterwards at Doltone House in Pyrmont.



Financial Position

During the past year the Board agreed that surplus cash in the current cheque account should be quarantined in a high interest bearing term deposit. Currently ACSE has around \$70,000.00 in this term deposit with a more modest working capital of around \$10,000.00 in the cheque account.

University Scholarship

The **ACSE Student Scholarship** provides assistance to find an interstate work experience placement for up to three months, and funding to the hosting firm to cover travel and accommodation expenses.

The 2013 Scholarship winner was Michael Chernyavsky who will take up a 3 month position with TTW in their Jakarta office. This year's 2014 scholarship recipient will be announced next week.

In recent years it has become increasingly difficult to attract student applications for the award. In 2014, despite advance promotion to all NSW Universities the Board was disappointed to see that only 3 suitable applicants applied for the Scholarship.

As a result the board has agreed that the 2014 Student Scholarship award will be the last ACSE student scholarship awarded and that resources will be put towards delivering a stronger lecture program to students and increasing the profile of the organisation at NSW Universities.

Practice Notes

The Board recognises that ACSE practice notes provide valuable technical back-up for practising consulting structural engineers. Following the successful breakfast meeting on Safety in Design, the Board is proposing an ACSE Safety in Design practice note for issue in early 2015.

In 2014 Board members attended meetings at the request of the NSW Department of infrastructure on proposals for mandatory inspection and certification of tied awning in NSW. The Board has advised the Department that the ACSE practice note 18 'Inspection & Assessment of Existing Tied Awnings' should be followed by engineers carrying out assessments of these awnings.



University Lecture Program

The 2014 University Lecture program at Sydney University was held during September and October 2014 and included the following guest lectures.

Date	Speaker	Topic
13 August	Rob McGowan (Partridge)	Creative aspects of structural engineering. Rob presented the design of the ACSE 2014 Small Projects award winning residential project that has a concrete façade with a very unorthodox load path and some other artwork projects that required some lateral engineering thought.
3 September	Nishmin Khambatta (TTW)	Post tensioned slab design and also some aspects of multi-storey design
17 September	Jonathon Low (Northrop)	Presentation on the earthquake code, seismic design and work Jonathon was involved with in Christchurch after the February 2011 earthquake
24 September	Charles Blumer (SDA)	Design and documentation steps of a small/medium residential project, including steel/timber/concrete /wind design and drawing / drafting conventions
22 October	Afshin Kazemi (ACOR)	Complete wind analysis for an industrial building in cyclonic area, including all possible wind pressure combination scenarios (internal and external pressures, openings, etc.)

The lectures were enthusiastically received by the lecturing staff and students and continue to be a successful contribution by the ACSE to the educating the next generation of engineers.

ACSE Support Staff

For the past 3 years, since ACSE terminated its ties with Consult Australia, the association has not employed any support staff to replace the administrative support previously provided by Consult Australia. The Board recognises that in order to provide the best service to members it needs to now employ a number of part time staff to help promote the organisation, market our events and establish sponsorship agreements. Ms Heidi Crawford has been appointed to this role in November 2014. An administrative assistants role is currently being filled.

Sponsorship

To support the costs of our events and salaries of our administration staff it is necessary for the ACSE to develop sponsorship agreements with a number of suitable sponsors. The first such agreement with Constructive Recruitment was signed this month.

ACSE Excellence Awards

The inaugural ACSE Structural Engineering Awards were held in 2013-2014. The purpose of the awards is to recognise and celebrate the role of NSW based Structural Engineers and their contribution to the built environment in NSW, Australia and throughout the world. The Awards aim to highlight excellence within the NSW Structural Engineering profession, assist in promoting Structural Engineers to our peers, fellow professionals and the general public, and showcase the role of Structural Engineering in a diversity of projects. The Awards are open to all NSW based Structural Engineering practices and professionals. 16 submissions were received in November 2013 from 5 companies (AJK Design; Bonacci Group; Northrop; Partridge and TTW) with judging in January 2014.

Awards Judging Committee included - Joe Agius (Director, Cox Richardson Architects) Australian Institute of Architects NSW President, Brian Uy (Professor of Structural Engineering & Director, UNSW), also representing IStructE and Andrew Simpson (SDA Structures) representing the ACSE Board.

The entrants were encouraged to invite all teams' members involved in the project entries to attend the presentation on February 26th 2014 at Hotel CBD. and it was particularly encouraging to see so many young structural engineers in attendance. The event offered an opportunity for engineers from the different companies represented to congregate and socialise and promote the best of our profession.
