

ACSE Golf Day Rules of Play

The competition will be an AMBROSE event and provide a challenge and a bit of fun. Simply all players tee off and for the next shot, choose the best available position of the four, and then all four play again from that position, then choose the best again and so on until the hole is completed.

The rules of Royal St Andrews and Avondale Golf Club will apply:

- 1. Each team will comprise four people. A Captain will be duly appointed (generally the lowest handicap). He/ she will be responsible for your card and decisions regarding who shoots from where during the round. He/ she will also select order of play for the team and this should be maintained during the round.
- 2. Handicaps will be limited to 27 for men and 36 for women and all shots are to be counted. The team handicap will be the sum of all the handicaps divided by two times the number of players in the team. The nett team score will be the gross score, less this handicap.
- 3. When putting on the green, the team must keep marking their balls until a putt is holed.
- 4. Each team member will be required to have his or her tee shot chosen at least three times during the round and his or her initials to be marked on the card.
- 5. Local rules still apply. Please refer to the score card and local notices.

Drive straight, putt well and enjoy!
