

### **ACSE Corporate Membership**

In July 2022 ACSE NSW will introduce Corporate Membership in addition to individual membership.

Companies may choose to take out a corporate membership with ACSE NSW rather than paying for multiple individual members.

Engineers that are listed in the company membership will need to meet same the application criteria as those making individual applications, with the exception of Chartered status. ACSE will accept corporate members who are “on the way” to chartership but may not yet have completed the process.

There is an allocation of the number of members that companies can include within each tier of corporate membership. This is an ‘up-to and including’ allocation. Firms are encouraged to include regional staff, and discounted fees are offered to regional members where they exceed the allocation allowance in a tier. Discounted membership fees are also available where the number of members exceeds the allocation available in the corporate membership package.

Members must be based in NSW.

#### **Small Company (up to 20 structural and technical staff) Membership - \$1,000 + GST**

- 3 senior members
- 3 associate members  
*Can include up to 2 members “on their way” to chartership*
- One free Award submission

#### **Medium Company (20 – 50 structural and technical staff) Membership - \$2,150 + GST**

- 6 senior members
- 4 associate members  
*Can include up to 4 members “on their way” to chartership*
- Two free award submissions

#### **Large Company (over 50 structural and technical staff) Membership - \$3,250 + GST**

- 9 senior members
- 6 associate members  
*Can include up to 4 members “on their way” to chartership*
- Three free award submissions

*Note - In all cases where the number of members exceeds the allocation available in the corporate membership package, additional members will be discounted to \$250 ex gst.*

**Corporate Membership Benefits:**

- Reduced event tickets
- Free Awards entries
- Discounted senior member fees and free associate members
- Streamlined annual renewal payment
- Access to ACSE member forums, sub committees and interagency network opportunities
- Use of ACSE logo on documents and email signatures
- Large firms can include members based in regional offices

**Corporate Membership Obligations:**

- Provide one membership representative to coordinate with ACSE Executive Officer about administrative matters and membership renewals
- Provide at least one representative at AGM and other members events
